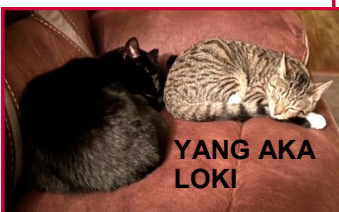
Tigress will help pet mom feel better!

Lady was adopted from us several years ago. As you can see she shared a strong bond with her family. There is nothing like the strength of the bond between a pet and their family.

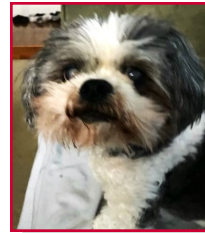

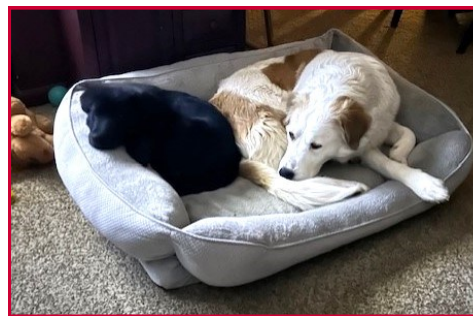
adored him. Thank you for letting us adopt him! He will be cremated (privately) and we will keep his ashes with us. Was the best baby!"

There was no eye in it. It had to be cleaned out and sewed shut. Bella was the angel that helped heal My Pet Parent's heart. Their little 14-year-old blind doggie just died from a heart that was failing. She was just precious when she came down to meet and greet Bella when they adopted Bella. Animal Sanctuary Society, Inc. was so so sad to hear the terribly sad news. And with their hearts broken they still came and adopted me even though I am about eight times their little beloved's weight. How can I not be thrilled! I am climbing on their laps even though I am so much bigger than their tiny beloved they let me on their laps. Bella loves to play but I am a gentle Giant that is so loved already in my new home.
